The shaped apron is richly carved with scrolling motifs and delicate cartouche details, showcasing the fluid, asymmetrical lines characteristic of the period. The warm and rich oak patina enhances the depth of the carving and highlights the natural grain of the wood. The table stands on a single graceful cabriole leg at the front, ending in a scroll foot, a sculptural and space-efficient design typical of corner consoles of the era.

The top is fitted with a variegated rouge marble surface with soft white veining and a molded edge, adding contrast and sophistication while providing a durable and practical surface.

This antique corner console is in excellent condition commensurate with age and use. A refined and highly decorative accent, ideal for a foyer, hallway, or powder room.
