The drawer displays traditional hand-cut construction and is fitted with period-appropriate hardware. Throughout, the table showcases a rich, naturally developed walnut patina that underscores its authenticity as a true period piece. Thanks to its well-balanced proportions, this antique table is ideally sized for use as a small writing desk, while also lending itself effortlessly to use as a console table, side table, or occasional table.
