Bring a sense of refined antiquity to your interior with this beautifully carved giltwood mirror from Provence, France. Crafted in Provence, France, circa 1780, the rectangular frame is crowned with an ornate crest featuring a carved lyre, horns, flutes, and foliate motifs—an homage to the decorative arts and musical symbolism beloved in the neoclassical period. Swagged laurel carvings cascade down each side, lending movement and symmetry to the composition. The mirror retains its original 18th-century glass plate, beautifully aged with scattered spotting that enhances its historic charm and textural depth. While visually authentic, the glass may want to be replaced for those preferring a clearer reflection. The frame, carved from solid wood and finished in its original gold leaf, shows a soft, time-worn patina that speaks to centuries of use. Measuring 25.5 inches wide by 35.5 inches high and 2 inches deep, this rare antique mirror is ideal above a console, fireplace, or in an entryway, and offers a striking blend of artistry, symbolism, and period craftsmanship.
