This ornate Italian wall plaque was crafted circa 1780 from hand-worked iron and finished in rich gilt, showcasing intricate openwork scrolls and foliate motifs in high relief. Likely part of a larger decorative ensemble or architectural element, the plaque features a symmetrical arrangement of acanthus leaves, curling tendrils, and stylized floral clusters. Traces of red bole beneath the gilding and areas of darkened patina lend depth and authenticity to the timeworn finish. Mounted on a custom blackened iron display stand, the plaque becomes a sculptural object suitable for tabletop or shelf display. Its square format (14.5" W x 1.5" D x 14.5" H without stand) offers bold decorative impact in a compact footprint. A striking example of 18th-century Italian metalwork with an elegant, aged luster. Excellent condition commensurate with age and use
