The desk is raised on sculptural lyre-form legs, joined by a dramatic hand-forged twisted iron stretcher that provides both strength and visual interest. The solid walnut construction boasts a warm, rich patina that has developed over nearly 250 years, lending an inviting glow to its surface. Fully finished on all sides, this piece can float elegantly in the center of a library, study, or executive office, becoming an instant focal point.
