Rustic and sculptural, this 18th-century side table was crafted in the Catalonia region of Spain from solid walnut. The rectangular top, fashioned from a single plank, features molded edges and a deep, hand-rubbed patina that reveals the wood's natural warmth and age-earned character. The table stands on bold, scalloped legs joined by a shaped stretcher, distinctive elements of Catalan furniture design in the 1700s. A single front drawer, carved with foliate motifs and fitted with its original wrought iron knob, opens to reveal hand-cut interior dividers, offering functional storage while showcasing the craftsmanship of the period. Compact in scale yet rich in presence, this antique table serves beautifully as a side table, or accent piece in Mediterranean, Spanish Colonial, or rustic settings. In excellent condition commensurate with age and use, the occasional table adorns a rich patina. The structurally sound speaks to its authenticity and enduring quality.
