The robust design recalls the enduring practicality of refectory tables used in monasteries and farmhouses, while the lighter bleached finish lends a fresh, modern versatility. In excellent condition commensurate with age and use, this antique French table would make a striking centerpiece in a dining room, kitchen, or wine cellar.
