This elegant 19th-century French Empire desk chair, carved circa 1870, features a sculptural mahogany frame with a rich, warm patina and classic neoclassical lines. The barrel-form back is gracefully curved, flowing seamlessly into bold, scroll-carved arm supports. The seat is upholstered in smooth black leather, secured with antique brass nailhead trim that adds a refined finishing touch. Raised on splayed back legs and front cabriole legs, the chair exhibits the balanced proportions and architectural presence characteristic of the Empire period. The carved detailing on the arm terminals, paired with the elegant silhouette, reflects the influence of Greco-Roman design so prominent in early 19th-century France.
