An elegant antique Louis Philippe mirror from France, crafted circa 1870. This 19th-century wall decor features a carved giltwood frame with rounded top corners and a subtly stepped profile, finished in its original gold leaf. Delicate engraved floral and foliate motifs wind along the inner border, lending a graceful decorative touch to the mirror's otherwise restrained silhouette. The original mercury glass plate is intact, exhibiting the characteristic softness and slight speckling associated with 19th-century glass. The wooden back panels are numbered and well-preserved, further affirming its period construction. Measuring 39 inches wide by 58 inches high, this nearly 5-foot-tall antique mirror is ideal above a mantel, console, in a powder room, or in an entryway. A timeless addition to traditional or transitional interiors, this French Louis Philippe mirror showcases the refined craftsmanship and understated sophistication of the era.
