This antique French mirror was crafted circa 1880 in the refined Louis XVI style and features a tall, narrow giltwood frame with elegant neoclassical detailing. The composition is crowned by a circular medallion mirror framed with carved laurel leaves and a tied ribbon crest, evoking classical symbols of virtue and honor. The rectangular lower mirror is bordered by a beaded inner trim and flanked by carved corner accents resembling stylized tassels or draped fabric. The frame is finished in gold leaf with a warm, aged patina that highlights the hand-carved details and adds antique depth to the surface. The reverse retains its original wooden back with visible tool marks, consistent with 19th-century provincial construction. Both mirror plates show mild foxing and silver loss appropriate to age, enhancing the piece's authentic charm. Measuring 12.5 inches wide by 23.5 inches high and 1.5 inches deep, this petite Louis XVI-style mirror offers a graceful accent for a powder room, hallway, or decorative vignette, bringing neoclassical elegance with a touch of French country character.
