



## 19TH C. FRENCH POPLAR, METAL AND BRASS-BOUND TRAVEL TRUNK STAMPED ED. L PARIS

This charming travel trunk was crafted in France circa 1895 from richly toned poplar and features robust brass and iron reinforcements. Stamped Ed. L Paris on the central lockplate, the piece is fitted with hardware supplied by a Parisian locksmith or trunk outfitter, part of a tradition where specialized artisans contributed high-quality fittings to the luggage workshops of the Belle Époque. The trunk is bound in blackened iron straps with brass corners and studded detailing that offer both strength and visual contrast. Two brass side latches secure the case, while original leather handles on either end provide sturdy grip and authentic character. The interior is cleanly lined in black textile, making it suitable for modern storage or display. Measuring 28 inches wide by 14 inches deep and 11 inches high, this antique trunk is perfectly scaled for use as a tabletop accent, stackable storage, or decorative accessory at the foot of a bed. A handsome and functional piece of 19th-century French travel history, blending artisanal materials with timeless Parisian style.
