This 19th century French mirror is crafted in the Louis XV Rococo style, with a richly carved giltwood frame that showcases the elegance and fluidity of the period. The surround is decorated with scrolling acanthus leaves, blossoming floral sprays, and intricate foliate motifs in high relief, all set against a finely textured ground. A delicately carved inner molding further enhances the original mirror plate. The gilded surface has developed a warm patina with age, with natural wear that underscores its antique authenticity. Measuring 37" high by 30" wide, the mirror is versatile and may be displayed vertically or horizontally, making it ideal above a console, in a powder room, or as a decorative wall accent. An authentic example of 19th century French Rococo revival design, this Louis XV, inspired giltwood mirror brings timeless sophistication to both traditional and eclectic interiors.
