Created in France by L'Hermine a Orchies, circa 1880, and almost square in shape, the antique porcelain cache pot features exquisitely rendered hunting motifs on all four sides, including deer, goose, wild boar, guns, horns, acorns and tree branches. The colorful planter is in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, and adorns rich colors in a green, light brown and beige palette. A great addition to a lodge, ranch or hunting resort.
