The curved left door features a wicker basket filled with a bundle of wheat, a hat and a harvesting scythe under the traditional Louis XVI ribbon bow. The right doors is embellished with a vase filled with grapes and other fruit, and features a similar carved bow at the top. The inside reveals shelving for ultimate storage. The large and elegant enfilade is in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, and adorns a rich bleached oak patinated finish.
