Enhance your home with this finely carved French Black Forest wall mirror, crafted circa 1880. Originally conceived as a clock housing, the piece has since been refitted with a round mirror plate, lending it both function and decorative appeal. The oak frame is richly carved in deep relief, featuring trailing floral garlands along the sides, a bold bouquet crest at the top, and scrolling acanthus ornamentation at the base. This antique French mirror displays a warm, well-preserved walnut-brown patina that accentuates the texture of the wood and the crispness of the carving, hallmarks of Black Forest craftsmanship. Measuring 20" wide by 29" high, it is a versatile size suitable for a hallway, bedroom, or above a console. In excellent condition commensurate with age and use, the mirror embodies both artistry and history, while its original purpose as a clock housing adds an intriguing layer of character.
