Decorate a study, hunting lodge, or rustic interior with this richly carved antique French oak mirror, crafted circa 1860 in the Black Forest style. The sculptural frame is densely ornamented with high-relief carvings of game, fruit, and foliage, including hanging game birds, clusters of grapes, and carved ribbons, all arranged around a central round mirror plate. The crest is crowned with a basket overflowing with carved fruit, adding height and dramatic presence to the composition.

The deeply carved oak surface showcases a warm and rich patina, highlighting the exceptional craftsmanship and dimensional quality of the relief work. The openwork silhouette and layered carving create movement and shadow throughout, giving the piece a bold, decorative presence from every angle.

The mirror retains a later replaced glass, while the back shows traditional wood construction. The antique wall mirror is in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, with minor wear consistent with its period, enhancing its authenticity and character.

This distinctive piece makes a striking focal point in a library, den, or mountain-style interior, bringing texture and old-world charm to the space.
