The table is supported by sculptural carved trestle bases joined by a substantial center stretcher, with shaped feet and traditional mortise and tenon joinery that speak to its durable craftsmanship. Sturdy, well balanced, and rich in rustic charm, this antique French refectory table is ideal for anchoring a dining room, breakfast nook, wine cellar, or country style kitchen, offering both everyday functionality and enduring provincial elegance.
