Crafted in France circa 1870, the colorful antique Louis XV hand mirror features elegant and intricate cloisonné decor throughout; it is further dressed with an inset beveled glass. The decorative vanity mirror is in excellent condition with bright and rich colors. Place this mirror in a master bathroom to check your make up or hair. Cloisonné or champlevé is an ancient technique for decorating metal or marble objects. In this technique, enamel, glass, or gemstones are separated by strips of flattened wire that are placed on a metal backing. Measures: 5.5" W x 13.25" H.
