This striking antique eagle sculpture was carved in France circa 1880 and beautifully captures the commanding presence of a bird of prey in refined naturalistic detail. Sculpted from a single block of variegated marble, the figure stands firmly atop a faceted rocky base, its powerful talons gripping the stone with convincing tension and realism. The marble displays dramatic natural veining in tones of smoky gray, cream, and warm beige, which enhances the feathered surface and adds remarkable depth and movement to the carving. Finely incised plumage along the wings and body is subtly defined, while the inset yellow glass eyes bring an arresting lifelike intensity to the eagle's forward gaze. Both sculptural and decorative, this 19th century French antique blends academic realism with strong decorative presence. Ideal for a library, study, or curated collection of animal sculptures, it makes a bold yet elegant statement.
