Bring a touch of authentic French countryside charm to your kitchen with this large 19th-century copper marmalade bowl. Crafted in Normandy, France circa 1880, this traditional bassine à confiture (jam pan) features a classic round form with two sturdy brass side handles secured with hand-hammered rivets. The richly polished copper surface gleams with warmth, reflecting the rustic elegance of a provincial kitchen. In good condition commensurate with age and use, this versatile antique can still serve its original culinary purpose, or be repurposed as a punch bowl, wine or beer cooler, or even as a striking centerpiece planter or cachepot.
