The rectangular top is fitted with a thick, polished black marble slab with a straight, clean-cut edge that reinforces the table's refined neoclassical silhouette. The frieze conceals a single long drawer with hand-cut dovetail joinery, offering discreet storage. The console is supported by four turned and ringed columnar legs, a classic Empire motif inspired by classical architecture. The legs rise from square block feet and are joined by a full lower shelf, providing additional display space while enhancing structural stability. The table is in excellent antique condition commensurate with age and use, with minor wear to the marble and walnut that adds to its authentic character. Ideal for an entry hall, behind a sofa, or beneath a mirror, this antique Empire console brings understated French elegance to both traditional and transitional interiors.
