This impressive antique French barbotine vase is a masterful example of faience artistry, distinguished by its richly applied floral relief and painterly glaze. Standing 27 inches tall and measuring 11.5 inches in diameter, the baluster-shaped vessel is hand painted in a soft gradient of greens, yellows, and earthy browns that highlight its organic form and provide depth to the overall composition. The front of the vase is adorned with an exuberant bouquet of sculpted flowers in full bloom, including roses, peonies, and hydrangeas, all individually modeled and glazed in naturalistic shades of burgundy, cream, lilac, and blush. Glossy green leaves and trailing blossoms continue up the neck and cascade onto the footed base, showcasing the exceptional craftsmanship and romantic sensibility of late 19th-century French ceramics. In excellent condition commensurate with age, with no major losses to the applied elements, this tall decorative faience vase offers striking visual impact and authentic antique charm. Ideal as a centerpiece or placed on a pedestal, it brings vibrant color and sculptural texture to traditional or eclectic interiors.
