This antique French Aubusson verdure tapestry was handwoven circa 1870 and depicts a lush wooded landscape animated by birds perched among twisting tree branches. Rendered in a classic verdure palette of layered greens, soft blues, warm ochres, and muted earth tones, the composition offers strong depth and decorative presence. Aubusson tapestries, woven in central France, are renowned for their painterly landscapes, refined color harmonies, and timeless appeal. Verdure scenes such as this were among the most sought-after designs produced by the Aubusson workshops and remain highly versatile for both traditional and transitional interiors. The tapestry is framed by an elaborate floral border featuring roses and stylized blossoms, accented with decorative urn cartouches and finished with a contrasting blue outer guard.
