Over five feet tall, the rectangular frame features softly rounded corners and a well-balanced profile, accented by a fine beaded inner molding and a subtly incised Greek key motif that adds quiet architectural interest without overpowering the design. The frame retains its original gold leaf finish, now aged to a warm, softly burnished patina with gentle wear that enhances its depth and authenticity. The mirror preserves its original mercury glass plate, displaying light veining, mild foxing, and tonal variation consistent with age and use, contributing to its refined, timeworn character. The original wooden backing remains intact, underscoring the quality and integrity of this well-preserved antique. Understated yet elegant, this Louis Philippe mirror is highly versatile and can be displayed leaning over a mantel, chest, or console, or hung vertically in an entryway, bedroom, or powder room, where its generous scale and soft gold finish add light, warmth, and classic French elegance.
