This elegant antique giltwood mirror was crafted in France circa 1870 and reflects the refined proportions of the Louis Philippe period. The tall rectangular frame is crowned with a softly arched crest, richly embellished with hand-carved floral garlands composed of roses and blossoms in high relief. The substantial molded surround features bold ribbed and reeded carving that creates depth and visual rhythm, while sculpted floral rosettes anchor each corner, lending balance and sculptural presence. The original gilt finish has developed a warm, timeworn patina with subtle tonal variations that highlight the crisp detailing and enhance its authentic antique character. The mercury glass plate displays age-appropriate foxing and speckling while the reverse reveals traditional plank construction consistent with mid-19th century craftsmanship. Weighing approximately 50 pounds, this substantial antique Louis Philippe mirror has a solid presence and can be securely hung over a mantel, placed atop a commode, or installed in an entry, powder room or bedroom.
