This monumental 19th-century French mantel mirror was crafted circa 1870. Measuring 49.25 inches wide by 70.5 inches high, it stands just under six feet tall, making it a striking architectural presence in any room. The frame features gently rounded moldings and finely carved floral appliqués at each corner and along the vertical rails, hallmarks of the Louis Philippe style, known for its refined restraint and elegant curves. The original water-gilt finish has developed a warm, time-softened patina that highlights the intricate hand-carved details. Retaining its original mercury glass plate, the mirror displays subtle, age-appropriate foxing that enhances its antique character. The back is constructed with wide, hand-planed pine boards, typical of 19th-century French craftsmanship. In excellent condition commensurate with age and use, this stately antique mirror would be ideal above a mantel, console, or as a dramatic focal point in a formal living room or entryway.
