Place this elegant antique Louis Philippe mirror above a commode, mantel, console, or in a refined powder room to instantly introduce warmth and period authenticity to a space. Crafted in France circa 1870, the mirror features the classic rounded rectangular silhouette associated with the style, defined by softly curved upper corners and a substantial molded profile. The wide giltwood frame is beautifully carved with a gently recessed cavetto molding, finely engraved with a subtle crosshatched ground that creates texture and quiet visual movement across the surface. A delicate inner beaded trim frames the glass and adds refinement to the composition. The frame retains its original water-gilt finish with natural rubbing, scattered dark specks, and light surface wear that reveal warm undertones beneath, enhancing its authentic timeworn character. The mirror plate is original mercury glass, showing soft oxidation and light age spotting consistent with its 19th century origin, giving the reflection a romantic depth while remaining fully functional. The reverse reveals old plank construction and period mounting, further confirming its antique craftsmanship. Excellent antique condition commensurate with age and use.
