The mirror retains its original mercury glass plate, displaying light oxidation and age spotting consistent with its 19th century origin, giving the reflection a soft, romantic depth while remaining fully functional. The reverse reveals old plank construction and period mounting hardware, further confirming its traditional craftsmanship.
