The backing has also been professionally replaced for added stability, and new hanging wire has been installed for secure and easy mounting. The silvered surface displays light wear and tonal variation consistent with age and use. Well proportioned for a powder room, hallway, dressing area, or above a small console or chest, this antique French wall mirror brings understated Louis Philippe elegance and timeless decorative appeal to both classic and transitional interiors.
