A single drawer with a decorative brass knob sits above a paneled door adorned with a turned wooden pull, opening to reveal a spacious storage compartment with one fixed interior shelf. Subtle carvings, including floral motifs and restrained moldings, reflect the quiet sophistication characteristic of the Louis Philippe period. The piece stands on four rounded bun feet, offering a stable and elegant base. In excellent condition commensurate with age and use, the cabinet boasts a warm, rich walnut patina.
