Entertain in style around this large antique fruitwood dining table. Crafted in France circa 1890, and built of solid walnut, the table features a thick rectangular top with hand-carved beveled edges, supported by two bold baluster-form pedestal legs connected by a sturdy cross stretcher, wedged mortise and tenon joinery. The beautifully turned legs sit atop wide, deeply carved plinth bases that ensure exceptional stability and presence. The piece showcases a warm, rich walnut patina that highlights the natural grain of the wood, along with subtle distressing and surface wear that add authentic character. Its rustic elegance and robust proportions embody the enduring charm of 19th-century French provincial craftsmanship. From the structure to the finish, this elegant refectory farm table is in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, and adorns a stylish, rich walnut patina. Stately yet inviting, this versatile, the Louis XIII style trestle table would sit 6 to 10 people comfortably; a wonderful size for a large breakfast room.
