



## 19TH CENTURY FRENCH LOUIS XIII SEVEN-LEG CHESTNUT FARMHOUSE RACETRACK TABLE

This interesting antique farmhouse table was crafted in southern France circa 1880 and reflects the enduring vernacular traditions of the Louis XIII style. Built in chestnut, the table features a single wide-plank top with softly rounded, racetrack-shaped ends, displaying a rich patina with visible grain, tool marks, and surface wear from generations of use. The top is supported by seven turned legs, including a central support, all joined by a full stretcher base that provides excellent stability and strong architectural presence. The turned legs and stretchers exhibit classic baluster forms typical of provincial French tables of the late 19th century, while the generous proportions make the piece highly functional as a dining table, harvest table, or center table. The chestnut surface retains a warm, time-softened patina with natural variations and wear consistent with age and use, contributing to its authentic antique character. Solid, well balanced, and visually grounded, this antique table is both practical and decorative. Dimensions: 92"W x 35"D x 29.75"H
