The seat is upholstered in new hand-dyed cognac leather, accented with antique brass nailhead trim for a tailored and classic touch. Plush and supportive, the cushion adds comfort without compromising the piece's sculptural silhouette. Measuring 42 inches wide by 16 inches deep and 21 inches high, this antique bench works beautifully at the foot of a bed, along a hallway, or as occasional seating in a salon. Excellent condition commensurate with age and use, with a beautiful light oak patinated finish.
