Elevate a console or dining table with this exquisite antique jardinière. Crafted in France circa 1870, the ornamental centerpiece is made of silver-plated bronze and features a richly contoured bombe form raised on four scrolled feet. The surface is adorned with finely cast rococo motifs including acanthus leaves, floral garlands, and asymmetrical scrollwork, all characteristic of the Louis XV decorative style. The scalloped upper rim flows elegantly into pierced handles at each end, enhancing both visual appeal and functionality. The jardinière retains its original removable zinc liner with aged verdigris patina, making it ideal for fresh floral arrangements or as a decorative cachepot. Measuring 17 inches wide, 11 inches deep, and 6.5 inches high, this silver-plated vessel is in excellent condition with light wear and tarnishing consistent with age and use.
