Decorate a grand hallway or mantel with this impressive antique Louis XV-style mirror. Crafted in France circa 1860, and almost 6.5 feet tall, the rectangular mirror is set within a hand-carved giltwood frame decorated with intricate floral and foliate motifs. The upper section features a dramatic pierced pediment topped with an exuberant bouquet of roses, scrolling acanthus leaves, and asymmetrical Rococo curves, all emphasizing the opulence of the period. The outer edges are enriched with delicate beading and stylized rosettes, while the inner molding is fluted for added depth and elegance. The bottom corners curve gently in the classic Louis XV serpentine form, each embellished with richly detailed foliage carving that blends seamlessly into the frame. The glass, showing subtle aging and light foxing, enhances the mirror's authenticity and charm. This elegant French mirror retains its original gilded finish with a beautifully aged patina, and is in excellent condition commensurate with age and use. With its commanding presence and ornate detailing, this wall decor would serve as a focal point in a traditional entryway, dining room, or living space.
