This charming antique wall mirror was crafted in Provence, France circa 1880 in the Louis XV style, known for its elegant curves and ornate detailing. The original mercury glass plate shows subtle silvering typical of 19th-century mirrors, enhancing its authentic character. A stylized cartouche crowns the top, while the shaped lower edge and side embellishments complete the Rococo-inspired silhouette.
