Decorate an entry or hallway with this elegant antique buffet console. Crafted in France circa 1870 and built of inlaid rosewood, the classic cabinet exemplifies the Louis XV style with a heavy presence, dramatic lines and beautiful gilt accents throughout. The cabinet stands on cabriole legs ending with decorative bronze-covered feet, over a scalloped apron decorated with swirling acanthus and straight-edge geometric motifs. The cabinet features one large single drawer across the front, with delicate bronze pulls and matching wreath-shaped escutcheon; the drawer is further embellished with intricate geometric parquetry motifs, and each corner is dressed with bronze mounts. The shaped surface is dressed with a variegated rust, gray, and white "Gris de Saint Anne" marble top. The console table with recessed side panels, is in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, and adorns a well-maintained rich walnut patina; it would make perfect table to display porcelain objects, frames, and more. Gris Sainte Anne Marble is a dark grey marble with white and light grey markings. It is quarried mainly in Belgium at Gougnies, near Charleroi and at Biesme, Namur. Measures: 54" W x 17.5" D x 32" H.
