The metal surround retains its original silvered finish with a warm, aged patina, making it ideal for displaying fresh floral arrangements, potted orchids, seasonal greenery, or as a dramatic decorative centerpiece. Raised on elegant scrolled feet, the jardinière is finely cast with crisp detail from every angle, showcasing the exceptional craftsmanship of the period.
