The feet are embellished with bronze sabots. The scalloped apron built of burl wood and marquetry motifs is further decorated with woman mounts and dressed with a bronze band in the style of neoclassical style of Napoleon III. and has beautiful marquetry work. The flower vase with a pierced bronze gallery is topped with the original cover tray dressed with small side handles.
