The Louis XIII style chairs rest on sturdy turned legs connected by classic H-stretchers, ensuring strength and stability. The open armchairs are fitted with shaped scrolled arms for additional comfort. The leather shows beautiful natural wear consistent with age, contributing to the set's character and authenticity. This well-preserved set would make an excellent addition to a breakfast or dining room, a wine cellar, pairing equally well with old refectory tables or rustic farmhouse trestle tables.
