This striking antique, hand-painted ceramic amphora was crafted in France circa 1890, and its scale and sculptural detailing instantly command attention. The generously proportioned vessel features a flared rim, rounded belly, and a pair of substantial handles modeled as twisted, time-worn grapevines. Across the entire body, richly glazed cabernet leaves and plump black grape clusters rise in high relief, their vibrant greens and deep purples set against a wonderfully mottled brown, amber, and chestnut marbled ground. The artisanal glazing technique gives the piece a warm, organic texture reminiscent of old wine casks aging in a dimly lit cellar. The amphora remains in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, with a lush palette that glows under light and highlights every sculpted vine. With its unmistakable wine country spirit and rustic French charm, this substantial 19th century vessel would make a showstopping accent in a wine cellar, tasting room, kitchen, or bar, perfect for adding a touch of vineyard romance to any interior.
