Decorate a kitchen, breakfast room, or covered patio with this elegant antique French baker's rack crafted in Paris circa 1880. Small in scale and narrow in profile, the piece is ideal for a corner or compact space, offering vertical storage without overwhelming the room. Constructed of hand-forged wrought iron, the slender étagère features graceful scrolled side panels and intricate spiral motifs that showcase the refined craftsmanship of late 19th century Parisian ironwork. The architectural silhouette is crowned with a shaped crest embellished with volutes and a central twisted finial, adding height and decorative movement. Three fixed slatted iron shelves, originally designed for cooling bread and pastries, now provide practical display space for ceramics, cookbooks, plants, or decorative objects. Slim front supports accented with brass posts and finials introduce warmth and contrast against the darker iron frame. The rack retains its rich aged patina with surface wear consistent with age and use, enhancing its authentic antique character. A stamped maker's mark reading "Perret Passage d'Allemagne Paris" appears along the lower rail, further confirming its Parisian origin. This antique French wrought iron baker's rack offers charm, function, and a space-conscious footprint, making it an excellent solution for tight corners, small kitchens, or layered decorative vignettes.
