Decorate a bar, kitchen shelf, wine cellar or tabletop with this charming set of six antique French pewter wine measures, crafted circa 1860. Each piece features a traditional baluster form with a flared foot and tapered neck, fitted with a hinged lid topped by a figural thumb lift. The sculptural handles and attached chains add movement and visual interest, while also referencing their original utilitarian design.

The vessels retain their authentic capacity stamps to the underside, a nod to their historic use in French cafés and wine houses, though they are now best suited for decorative display. The hand-finished pewter surfaces exhibit a soft, time-worn patina with gentle tonal variation, enhancing their antique character.

The antique set is in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, with minor wear and oxidation consistent with handling over time. A versatile decorative grouping ideal for a bar vignette, open shelving, or a rustic French interior.
