Decorate a powder room, entry, or intimate wall space with this charming antique French repoussé brass mirror, crafted circa 1880. The piece features a refined architectural frame topped with an arched crest centered by a winged cherub emerging from a radiating sunburst, flanked by scrolling volutes.

The rectangular frame is structured with classical panel divisions and small rosette accents at the corners, lending a balanced, neoclassical composition. The lower apron is finished with a delicate leaf motif, while the mirror rests on two small spherical feet, allowing it to be displayed on a tabletop or mounted on the wall.

The brass surface has developed a warm, time-softened patina that enhances the depth of the repoussé detailing. The mirror retains its original backing and shows wear consistent with age and use, adding to its authentic antique character. A versatile decorative accent, ideal for layering into a gallery wall or adding a touch of French charm to a smaller space.
