Under the hinged glass door, the facade is richly embellished with hand cut mother-of-pearl floral and foliate inlays, shimmering against the walnut stained background and surrounding the porcelain and enamel dial with its stylized Roman numerals. This antique timekeeper houses a traditional French movement that has been fully cleaned and serviced by our horologist, ensuring excellent working condition commensurate with age and use.
