Elevate a console or center table with this refined antique Imari bowl mounted on an ornate gilt bronze stand, crafted in Japan and France circa 1860. The shallow porcelain dish is beautifully hand painted in a classic Imari palette, featuring intricate floral and foliate motifs in rich iron red and deep cobalt blue, accented with delicate gilt highlights. The composition centers a stylized medallion, framed by scrolling patterns and botanical elements that bring movement and elegance to the piece.

The Japanese porcelain is set within an elaborate Louis XV style dore bronze mount, richly cast with openwork, scrolling acanthus details, and decorative side handles. The elevated pedestal base adds height and presence, creating a striking fusion of Eastern artistry and European decorative taste.
