The table is supported by a slender iron pedestal with gilt accents, resting on a finely cast tripartite base adorned with stylized French dolphin motifs, an ornamental flourish emblematic of the Second Empire aesthetic. The iron retains its original black finish with gilt highlights that enhance its antique appeal. Measuring 20 inches in diameter and 27 inches high, this petite guéridon is ideal for a breakfast nook, covered terrace, or as a decorative accent table. Good condition commensurate with age and use.
