Built of solid oak in the Louis XIII taste, each chair features a tall shaped back and square seat upholstered in richly patinated brown leather secured with oversized hand-forged iron nailheads. The aged leather displays beautiful tonal variation and wear acquired over generations, giving the set an authentic and inviting presence.

The sturdy oak frames stand on finely turned legs connected by classic double H-form stretchers, a hallmark of Spanish and Renaissance-inspired furniture of the period. Strong architectural lines paired with the warm leather upholstery create a refined yet rustic aesthetic equally suited for a farmhouse table, Mediterranean interior, or château-style dining room.

This antique set remains in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, and adorns a deep walnut-toned patina with desirable wear throughout. The chairs are comfortable, stable, and ready for everyday use while offering the timeless appeal collectors seek in authentic Spanish furniture.
