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Bring classic French elegance to a dining room or breakfast room with this handsome antique-style extension dining table. Crafted in France circa 1980, the oak table is designed in the graceful Louis XV taste, standing on elegant cabriole legs adorned with hand-carved acanthus motifs and ending in delicate escargot feet. The scalloped apron is richly embellished with a finely carved central shell cartouche flanked by floral and foliate decoration, showcasing the quality of French craftsmanship.

The beautifully figured oak top features an eye-catching parquetry veneer arranged in a geometric pattern and framed by a molded border with softly rounded corners. The warm honey-colored finish highlights the natural grain of the oak, creating a welcoming and timeless appearance. The table is fitted with a traditional pull-out extension mechanism and includes two original leaves, allowing it to expand from a compact everyday dining table to an impressive 102-inch length for entertaining family and guests.

The antique extension dining table is in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, with a rich patinated finish, sturdy construction, and beautifully preserved carved details. Its elegant proportions and versatile Louis XV styling make it equally at home in a French country, farmhouse, traditional, or transitional interior.
