



## EARLY 18TH CENTURY SPANISH CATALAN CARVED WALNUT TWO- DOOR BUFFET CABINET

This exceptional antique cabinet was hand-carved in northern Spain circa 1720 and reflects the bold architectural character of the Spanish Baroque period. Crafted from solid walnut, the piece is built with impressive thickness and integrity, showcasing traditional joinery and the enduring quality of early 18th century craftsmanship. The façade is defined by deeply recessed geometric raised panels across both doors and sides, creating strong shadow lines and a rhythmic, almost fortress-like presence. The doors retain their original forged iron pulls and escutcheon, each element hand-worked and beautifully aged, adding an authentic touch of period blacksmithing. The rich walnut surface displays a warm, timeworn patina with subtle variations in tone that only centuries of use can produce. Inside, the cabinet opens to reveal generous shelving, offering practical storage while maintaining its sculptural exterior presence. The scale and proportions make it highly versatile; it can function as a statement buffet, a media cabinet to discreetly conceal electronics, or a refined storage piece in a bedroom or hallway.

The antique cabinet is in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, and adorns a rich walnut patina throughout. A striking example of early Spanish craftsmanship, this circa 1720 piece brings depth, history, and architectural gravitas to any interior.
